Minutes

1. Welcome and apologies

Lotta Haglund (LH), Vice President of EAHIL, welcomed attendees to the General Assembly (GA) at EAHIL's workshop in Edinburgh. The General Assembly was confirmed to be a quorum. Apology for absence was received from Carol Lefebvre. The Board members introduced themselves

2. Announcements

- a. Information from Health Information & Libraries Journal that one free online issue is offered each year
- b. The Board suggests making Sally Wood, former editor of JEAHIL, an honorary member of EAHIL. This was approved by the General Assembly

3. Minutes of the General Assembly 2014 (Rome)

The General Assembly accepted the minutes as an accurate document. They will be made available on the EAHIL web site.

4. President's report

Marshall Dozier (MD) summarized presidential reports, which give a summary of the activities of the Association and its representatives for the year. She focused on the importance of the work of different groups and committees. There are vacancies in the Council, MD encouraged members to stand as candidates for the Council and asked for help to recruit new members both to the Council and to EAHIL. The report is available on the EAHIL web site.

5. Secretariat Supervisor's report

Suzanne Bakker (SB) reported on the administration of the organization. All operations works smoothly. The membership database will soon have implemented a workflow for Council members for approval of new membership applications. Open Journal System is installed on the EAHIL web server and the process of moving the EAHIL journal to the OJS server can start.

6. JEAHIL Editor's Report

Federica Napolitani Cheyne (FN) introduced herself as the new editor in chief, she reported on changes in the JEAHIL Editorial Board and about how the work is organized. New is that the members of the board are responsible for special theme issues. A survey on JEAHIL was submitted to all members at the end of 2014; the results will be useful to improve the journal and will be presented in an article later.

7. Amendments to EAHIL Rules of Procedure and Policy Statements

EAHIL has three types of formal documents: (1) Statutes - legal documents, (2) Rules of

procedures, (3) Policy statements. (2) and (3) can be changed by the General Assembly. Current EAHIL Policy Statements can be found at the EAHIL web site

- a. Policy Statement 4f – on when SIG reports are made: *“The subgroup must submit a formal annual report to the EAHIL Board in advance of the ...”*

The Board proposed that subgroups submit their reports after the yearly summer meetings. Approved by the General Assembly

9. EAHIL Web site

Anna Kågedal (AK) reported on the status of the EAHIL web site. The web site phase 1 was launched in May; the new web site fulfils most of the specified needs. Further work will take into account the results from the usability test, and also focus on better solution for formal EAHIL documents and integration of the EAHIL Journal Integration of the Journal
